a. CALL TO ORDER 7:30 PM – Meeting called to order by: President Hayley Bradt

b. Treasurer:

- 1. Financials- Operating budget- \$261,325 Reserves- \$55,859 = \$319,677 total. We will be transferring 10% into reserves monthly. Board approves moving mandated 10% of operating funds to reserves for 2018 and 2019.
- 2. Board has requested that CMA send HHOA payment notices in January of each year.

c. Architectural Control Items:

- 1. 32 ACC violation letters have been sent out to homeowners.
- 2. The online survey is showing that the majority of residents do not use the H3 tennis courts much, and would be interested in a greenspace/playground area in the future.

d. House and Grounds Items:

- 1. Board approves playground mulch for both playgrounds with a projected install date of May 14.
- 2. Board approves to follow-up on the issue of the H3 detention pond hold water. We will be meeting an engineer to determine if any environmental impact was due to this.
- 3. A police report and insurance information was recently obtained to move forward with the damaged bushes on Shallowford for replacement/payment.

e. Pool:

- 1. The ramp/stairs to the outside women's bath door is being re-built. The board is also installing new fire extinguisher, smoke detectors, and having both pumphouse completely clean out. All of these items were listed as necessary for insurance compliance.
- 2. The phones are still not working at the pools, but the board approved switching service back to AT&T in hopes of better service to fix the issues.
- 3. Nautix will check all the umbrellas to see how many are broken, and if any need to be ordered for the season.

f. Communications:

- 1. Graduation signs are going up at all the entrances this week.
- 2. Hedgerow magnets with local numbers and information will be distributed to each home in the next 2 weeks.

g. Capital Improvement:

- 1. ABC has declined the pavilion construction due to the timeline being pushed to September. The board will be seeking new bids for construction.
- 2. A few more adjustments are being made to the architect's plan.

h. Tennis:

- 1. Board approves pressure washing the H1 courts by a professional that specialized in court washing to prevent damage.
- 2. An electrician was hired to fix an electrical issue with the court gate.

i. Other Business:
